

Conditions for inscription (number of places, fees, minimum age, previous degrees required, level of knowledge of Spanish, etc.): Number of places: 60 (maximum). Minimum age: 16. Total cost of the Course: 15,250 pesetas, which includes lodging (full board), excursions, visits, etc. (there are no other expenses of any kind).



This Course is divided into three groups (Upper Course, wide knowledge; Intermediate Course and Elementary Course, basic ideas). In addition, there are classes and lectures on Spanish Literature, History of Spain, Spanish Art, Spanish Geography, Philosophy, Music and Folklore.

Other cultural activities: The Student Card which will be given students at the time of inscription allows them to visit free the Museums, Libraries and Monuments which are dependencies of the Ministerio de Educación y Ciencia.

Artistic-cultural excursions which can be made: During the Course the students will be able to make trips to various cities of historic and artistic interest: Toledo, El Escorial, Aranjuez, Avila, Salamanca, La Granja, Segovia, Alcalá de Henares, etc. The expenses for these trips are not included in the fees and must be requested ahead of time in the Oficina Nacional de Viajes de Jóvenes Estudiantes (Fernando el Católico, 88, Madrid-15).

Conditions for inscription (number of places, fees, minimum age, previous degrees required, level of knowledge of Spanish, etc.): Matriculation: 8,000 pesetas and 2 photos. The matriculation is open from February 27th to March 15th, 1978. Minimum age: 16. Level of knowledge of Spanish: basic.



Other observations: For the Diploma of Bilingual Secretary it is necessary to achieve a minimum of 175 pusations per minute. Economic assistance is given to students and teachers. There are exchanges of students between the Spanish college and toreign colleges (the student lives in the home of the foreigner and viceversa). This system is very economical and only the classes are paid for). These Courses have been given since 1973.

Name of the Course: Course in Spanish Language and Culture.

Organized by: C.I.L.C.E. (International Center for Spanish Language and Culture).

Lodgings: With Spanish families who generally have children of the same age as the foreign students. In this way there is the opportunity to come to know our mentality, culture, social custums, etc., make friends and practice our language.

Other observations: in all Courses there is a minimum or four levels: elementary, superior and two mcdium courses. There is a maximum of 12 students per class.
